For parents of students enrolled in Secondary IV or V in general education in the youth sector

Subject: Creating an account for the online consultation of the student's academic record at the Ministère de l'Éducation.

Students can now consult an online academic record service to view their marks and diplomas earned in secondary school and vocational training.

To do so, students are asked to click on the “Online services” section of the education.gouv.qc.ca website to create their account. The process is quite simple and user friendly.

Students will then be prompted for certain personal information, such as their **permanent code** and **file number**, which allow us to identify them. If students do not already have this information, the educational institution can help them obtain it.

Students enrolled in general education in the youth sector are strongly encouraged to create their account before the end of the school year. Their marks will be available starting July 5, 2022, and they will be able to access them right away. Students may also use this service to request a review of the correction of their uniform examinations.

Students enrolled in **adult general education** or **vocational training** can create their account at their convenience. Please note that only one account can be opened per permanent code.
